***NEW THIS YEAR :**

CHIP TIMING: All registered participants will receive a Race Number which includes a "chip" for timing purposes. Each finisher's time will be immediately sent to a computer. (\$5 fee for replacement of race numbers.)

ONLINE REGISTRATION: Register in person or register and pay online at www.victoryinthevalley.org

TEAM PHOTO: All teams will have an opportunity to have a "Team Photo" taken on the plaza. A copy will be emailed to the Team Captain following the event for distribution to team members.

5K (3.1 mile) RACE – USATF CERTIFIED - Award categories in the 5K are: 12 & under, 13-15, 16-19 and 5 year groups to 70 & over. A prize will be awarded to the top male and female finisher. 5K awards will be based upon net time (chip time) except for the "Overall Male & Female Winner" which will be based on "gun time." (For safety, no strollers allowed)

2K (1.2 mile) WALK - Award categories in the 5K are 10 year groups from 19 & under to 80 & over. With the benefit of the new "Chip Timing," each race participant's time will begin when they cross the Start Line and end when they cross the Finish Line.

1K (.6 mile) CELEBRATION STROLL (untimed) Cancer Survivors and those who support them may walk this VICTORY lap together in celebration of life. All Cancer Survivors will receive a purple balloon to carry through the Celebration Stroll and onto the bridge for the Survivor Balloon Launch.

1K (.6 mile) KIDS RUN ~ (12 & under) Individual medals are awarded for the fastest running times for age groups 6 & under, 7-8, 9-10 and 11-12. Every finisher in this race will receive a gift donated by Abuelo's restaurant. For safety reasons, kids age 8 and under will start 5 minutes later. (Parents may accompany young children ON SIDELINES.) A prize will be awarded to the top boy and girl finisher. (Note: All youth awards will be based on "gun time" and not "chip time.") Children are invited to visit the Kid's Tent on the Plaza for fun activities.

FOOD COURT

Chris Cakes will be providing a breakfast of pancakes, sausage and juice from 8am – 11am and coffee will be provided by Caffé Moderne. Please remember to bring the food court ticket provided in your race packet. Additional food court tickets are available for \$8.00. Hang onto your plate for the all you can eat!

SURVIVOR RECOGNITION

In addition to the different race events, cancer survivors will release balloons in celebration of cancer survivorship. All survivors will receive a "Survivor's Scarf" with registration packet to wear on Race Day in Celebration of Life.

For safety reasons, NO ANIMALS are allowed on the course. (Assist dogs are permitted). Strollers permitted in Walk & Celebration Stroll only.

TEAM REGISTRATION – BEGINS MAY 3RD ~ ENDS TUESDAY, JUNE 1ST at 3pm. You may form your own team simply by signing up 10 or more friends, family members, neighbors or co-workers. Team Registration must be done at Victory House. Captains of the four largest individual and corporate teams will receive an award on race day. In addition, "The Rose Award" will be given to the team or individual who raises the largest amount of money to benefit Victory in the Valley.

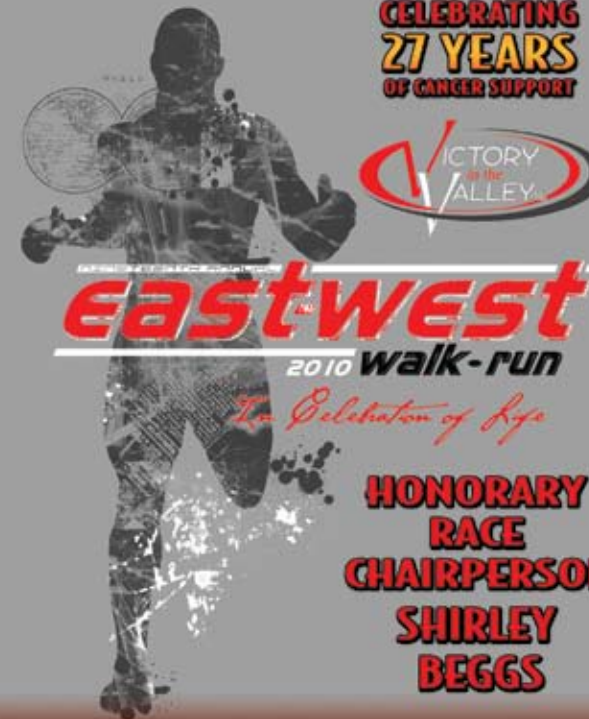
